What is VBS? Vacation Bible School is a four-day faith-filled AND fun-filled adventure for participants of ages four through those entering 5th



grade in the fall of 2024! Participants who will be four in the fall and are potty trained are eligible to register at the preschool level. # Scripture of the Week



"After the man, Adam, had eaten of the tree, the Lord God called to the man and asked him, "Where are you?"" (Genesis 3:9)

Where are you? That was the question God asked Adam in the garden, but it is also the same question He asks each one of us. We see a common reaction from people in today's Gospel reading when even Jesus's own relatives write Him off as crazy. Do we write Him off? Do we try to hide in various ways in our own lives?

Like Adam and Eve, we try to hide ourselves when we fall into sin. And Satan is more than happy to help us hide! We find it hard sometimes to believe in a God so good He would die for our sins, but that is the truth, and His name is Jesus. As St. Paul says in our Second Reading: "we are not discouraged ... our inner self is being renewed day by day." Step out of the shadows and say "Yes!" to God's love.




