Mini Reflection:

Sometimes we forget, or
even refuse, to bring

inconveniences to God
because we think we
should be able to handle
them on our own. What a
ridiculous attitude that is
- as if we could handle
anything on our own.

Gospel Reflection:

I once ran out of pizza at
my kid's birthday party.

Everyone told me it
wasn't a big deal but come *on*. It was a disaster. I had invited all these people
over. They showed up with presents and sang "Happy Birthday" and stood
around patiently while my kid ripped through his cache of gifts. The very least
they were expecting was to be fed sufficiently.

I'll tell you what, I sure could have used the Blessed Mother that night.

I love the story of the wedding at Cana because it's such a silly little miracle. I
don't mean to be disrespectful - of course it's an incredibly important moment in
Christ's public life. But it's not healing a leper. It's not raising the dead. It's not
even walking on water. It's saving a young couple from embarrassment.

**I think sometimes we forget, or even refuse, to bring small concerns and
inconveniences to God because we think we should be able to handle them on
our own.** What a ridiculous attitude that is – as if we could handle anything on
our own. It's so fitting that Mary, ever the observant Mother, is the one to bring
the matter to Jesus' attention. He asks her what this problem has to do with Him.
She doesn't answer Him, because, between you and me, I don't think He's
asking her. I think He's asking us. All she does is tell the waiters what I consider
to be **the best piece of advice in all of Scripture: "Do whatever he tells you."**

I'm so quick to throw up my hands and feel sorry for myself when I encounter a
barrier in my life. What I should be doing is taking the matter to God, and then
doing whatever He tells me.

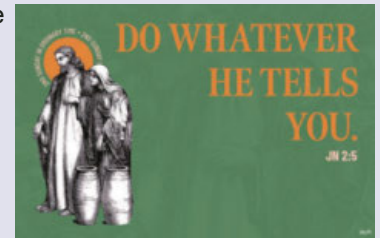


Scripture of the Week



"His mother said to the servers, 'Do whatever He tells you'" (John 2:5)

This week we begin the transition to Ordinary Time in our church calendar. Our readings focus on something of an introduction to the person and ministry of Jesus. We hear prophecy from Isaiah reminding us of God's covenant relationship with Israel. Our Psalm instructs us to rejoice and announce His coming. St. Paul reminds us we are in relationship with God as a community of believers. And our Gospel announces the first step in the public ministry of Jesus.



This week's Gospel passage records the very last words we hear from Mary in the Gospels. "Do whatever He tells you" - "He" meaning Jesus. From our first meeting of Mary when she says "Behold, I am the handmaid of the Lord, let it be done to me according to His will" to today's words from Mary she never waivers in pointing to God. Let her response to God be ours as well.

What: A night to celebrate your marriage with your spouse and others; speakers, blessing, remembering vows and fellowship

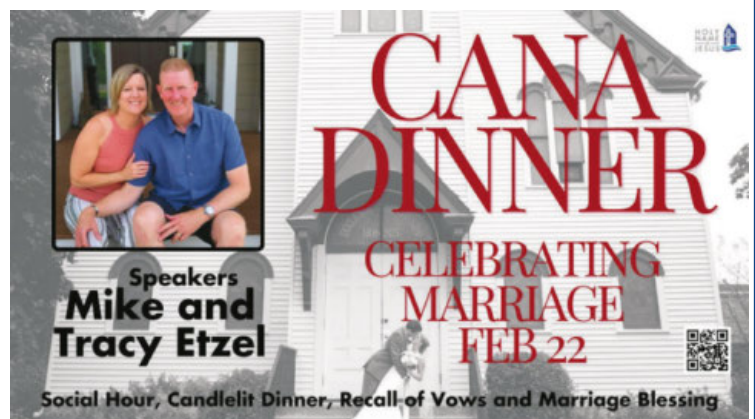

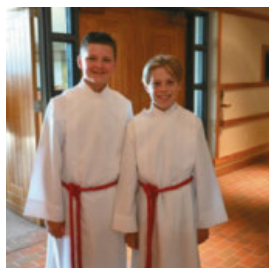


In Our Parish and Our Community

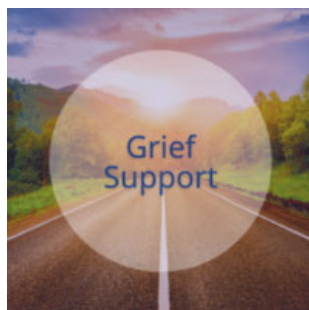


West Suburban Grief Coalition, Thursdays

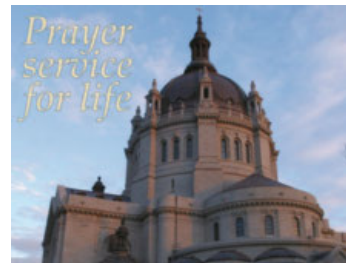

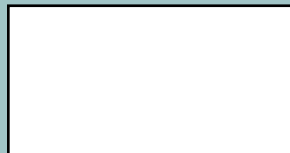
