

A Joyful Alleluia!

Known most for its “Hallelujah” chorus, Handel’s “Messiah” premiered in London in the year 1743. While it officially premiered the previous year in Dublin, the first performance in London had the honor of having King George II in attendance. While the fifty-three movements bear impressive musical elements that narrate the story of Christ and His work of salvation, none is perhaps as moving as that “Hallelujah” chorus. It was likely so for King George II, who stood during the premiere of this chorus in London. Why he stood we do not know exactly, whether he was moved by the beauty, was experiencing a cramp in his leg, or was desiring to show honor to the King of Kings, Jesus Christ. The uncertainty of the answer has no bearing on the legacy of this act, as it remains tradition for those in attendance at Handel’s Messiah to stand when the “Hallelujah” chorus is sung.

On Easter Sunday, we rise before the proclamation of the Gospel to sing “Alleluia” once again after forty long days of Lent. We stand not to imitate King George II as at a musical performance but rather to show honor to the King of Kings, who is not dead but risen in glory! We stand to echo the joyful strain of many Christian brothers and sisters who have stood throughout the ages to proclaim that Jesus Christ is alive and continues to reign! Handel’s “Hallelujah” chorus captures this Christian proclamation through the ages when different sections of the chorus repeat, one after another “And He shall reign for ever and ever” to a cascading effect. At the same time, Handel joins together these shouts of praise by Christians of different times and places in one homophony of “Hallelujah” to conclude the chorus in triumphant spirit.

As we celebrate our Lord’s resurrection, may we echo that joyful alleluia to our families, friends and communities, that they may recognize the beauty of this alleluia and rise to encounter the King of Kings whose herald this alleluia is.





What is VBS?

Vacation Bible School is a special four-day faith-filled AND fun-filled time to kick off the summer and get closer to the Lord. Open to kids ages four through 5th grade (entering 5th grade in the fall of 2025,) kids will have the opportunity to make friends, craft, sing, play games, pray and learn about God's love, with the Holy Spirit as our guide. Children who will be four in the fall and are potty trained are eligible to register at the preschool level. Each day, participants will spend time at four centers designed to help see and feel the role of the Holy Spirit in the Bible, the Church, and our lives, all in a child-friendly way. Vacation Bible School teen and adult volunteers needed!



Divine Mercy Sunday, April 27

From Saint Faustina's diary: "Jesus said to me, Paint an image according to the pattern you see, with the signature: Jesus, I trust in You. I desire that this image be venerated, first in your chapel, and then throughout the world... I desire that there be a Feast of Mercy. I want this image to be solemnly blessed on the first Sunday after Easter; that Sunday is to be the Feast of Mercy." (Diary of Saint Faustina, Notebook 1, paragraphs 47 and 49).

At HNOJ there will be a Divine Mercy Chaplet prayed after all the Sunday Masses on April 27, with Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament. This prayer is spoken, and prayed using an ordinary Rosary. This prayer contains the repetition of praying the phrase, "For the sake of His sorrowful Passion, have mercy on us and on the whole world".


