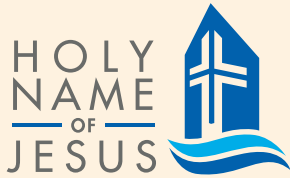

Your Report on the Results of the Stewardship Campaign Pledge Drive

Thank you to those who responded with your pledge commitment to HNOJ for 2020. Your faithful support will help ensure that our parish community flourishes. Look for financial updates in the bulletin and on the website.

The response to the pledge drive decreased compared to last year and has fallen short of the overall goal. Here are some of the results:

- Our total pledged amount was \$1,509,541 vs. our goal of \$2,131,000
- 514 pledges were received from parish households or a 20.31% response rate
- 119 parish families responded with new pledges for 2020
- 152 parish families increased their pledges over last year
